

## LINE HISTORY CAMILLA INTELIGENTE

During the following days, his evolution was not favorably, a traction injury at the cervical level that affected the left half of his body was found. In other words, a new and serious condition outside of the accident suffered and subsequent to it (medullary hemi compression). While researching about it, I discovered that the current methods of both extra and in-hospital transfers in Argentina are similar in Europe, the U.S.A. and other first world countries. In other words, in this case, we can affirm that the medical rescue instruments did not fail, but given the case that since the Roman times the concept of moving someone did not evolve, regular sheets, canvases and one piece stretchers, are still in force plus handling (traction, rotation and rotation) on the injured person. That is where CAMILLA INTELIGENTE® is born, in the need to evolve when in need of transfer of a human being and humanizing it, exercising its innovation through the anatomy of the body itself and without aggravating existing injuries or generating new ones, as seen on case of the delivery person.

With the problem clearly identified and after a long time of researching, parallel to the work obligations I had, I decided it was time for the idea to become a prototype, and so it was. Against all the statistics, in a country where entrepreneurship was just taking its first steps, we achieved the first goal, but it was only the beginning of this story since once the prototype was finished, the starting line was crossed, not the finish one. We received several and even international awards, but we went for more.
